Introduction

This user guide shows you how to report unit census using case capture, an electronic form in the ICU Data Capture System (DCS).

Please note that there is an alternative way to enter unit census data: the Data Upload Wizard. For details, please see the Data Upload Wizard user guide.

Unit census data refer to the number of patients in the unit and the number of total blood culture sets taken in the unit; they are required as denominators to calculate the rates of infection, blood culture positivity and CVC utilisation.

Unit census can be reported on a monthly or daily basis.

Accessing the case capture form

Once you have logged into the ICU DCS, there are two ways of accessing the case capture form: via the Case Capture link or via the Search link.

Using the Case Capture link

- From the Menu Toolbar on the left hand side of the screen, click on 'Case Capture' link (Figure 1).
- Click on 'Enter a case'.

Using the Search function

Alternatively, if you need to first check whether a unit census for the required period has been already submitted, you can use the Search functionality; please see the 'Search, amend or delete records' user guide for details. From there, you will be able to report a new case: you will be redirected to the case capture form (**Error! Reference source not found.** for 'ICU Monthly Census' and Figure 5 for 'ICU Daily Census').

Case capture forms

Throughout the tabs:

- Fields marked with a red asterisk (*) are mandatory for saving: you will not be able to save the census or continue to the next tab until you have completed these sections with data that is within the range of accepted values.
- Fields marked with a red hash (#) are mandatory for sign-off. If one of these fields is left incomplete for even a single record, it will not be possible to sign off the whole month's worth of data (see the 'Sign-off' user guide for details). Please see these fields as mandatory; however, sometimes the data for these fields becomes available at a later point, the functionality of 'mandatory for sign-off' gives users a buffer of time to update these at a later point (but no later than the sign-off deadline).
- Blue question mark icons (²) can be clicked to obtain further information on some fields

'Episode Details' tab (monthly)

If 'ICU Monthly Census' is selected the DCS will navigate you to the Episode Details tab (Figure 3).

'Data Collection Date' needs to be entered in dd/mm/yyyy format. You may use the calendar icon (IIII) to facilitate the identification of a specific day, month, and year.

Please note that if a data entry already exists for the date entered, a duplicates warning will pop up to inform you of this. Only one entry per day per unit is possible as these data are for the entire unit and day. If you need to amend values for a previously entered date, please use the Search functionality to find the relevant entry and amend from there.
